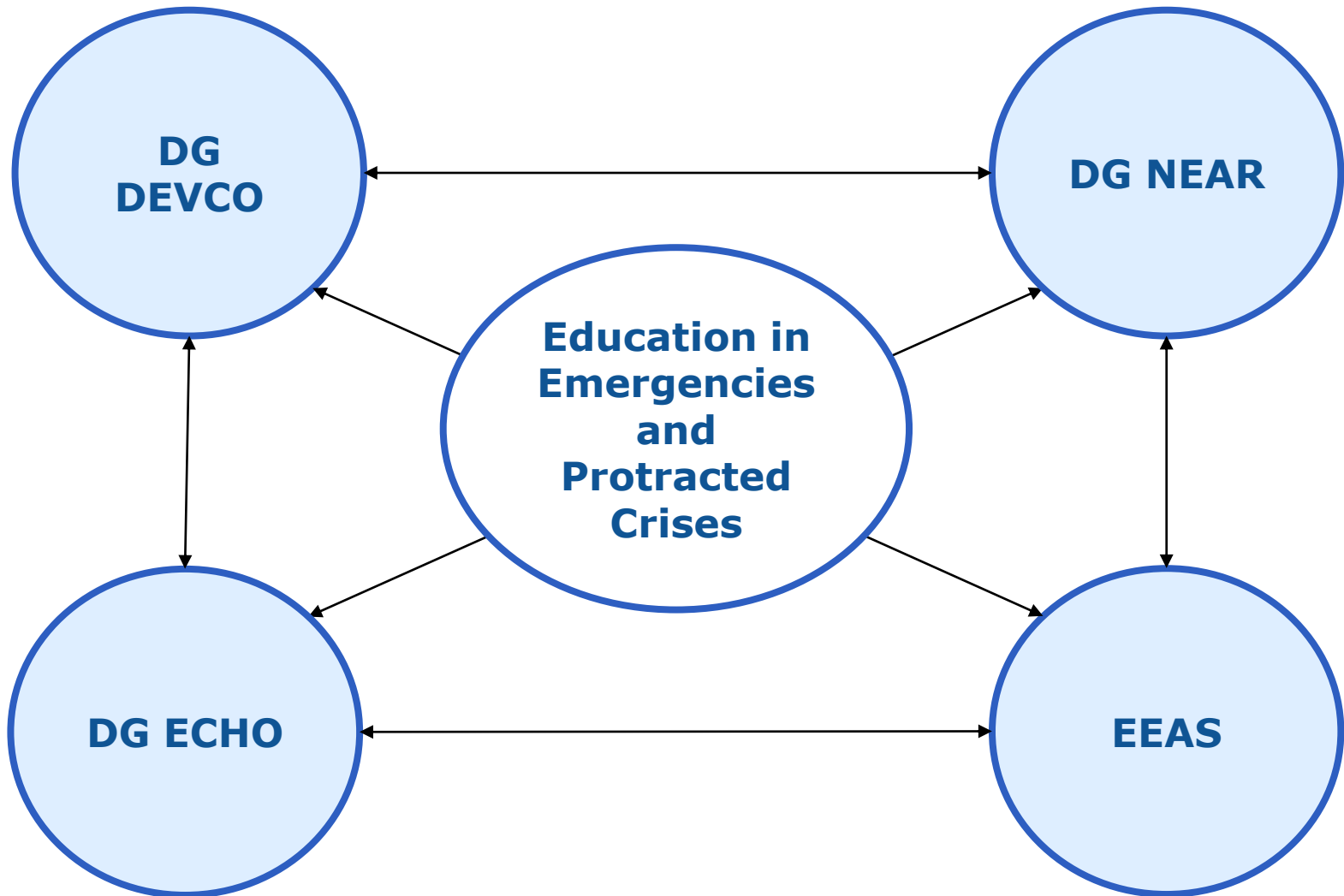

## **Policy:**

- Communication on Education in Emergencies and Protracted Crises, COM (2018) 304, May 2018.
- 4 priorities: access, quality, partnerships/coordination and protection/peace

## **Programming (2014-2020)**

### *Bi-lateral support:*

- EUR 5.3 billion in over 50 developing countries, half of these are fragile and/or conflict affected.
- Main focus: education system strengthening, access and quality, primary and lower secondary education, protection
- Partners: Governments, UN agencies (UNICEF/UNESCO), INGO, local CSO

### *Global support:*

- ECW – Education Cannot Wait (EUR 16 million)
- GPE – Global Partnership for Education (EUR 475 million)
- BRiCE – Building Resilience in Crises through Education (EUR 21 million): Oxfam/Ibis, Plan International, NRC and Save the Children
