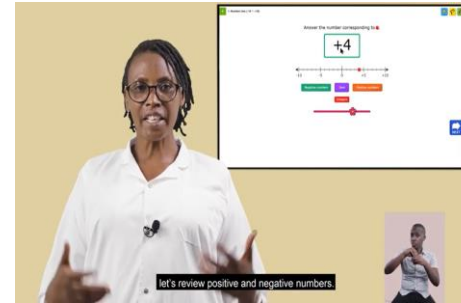

Connecting more schools to the internet using 4G network and Fibre to reach 2024 target of 85%



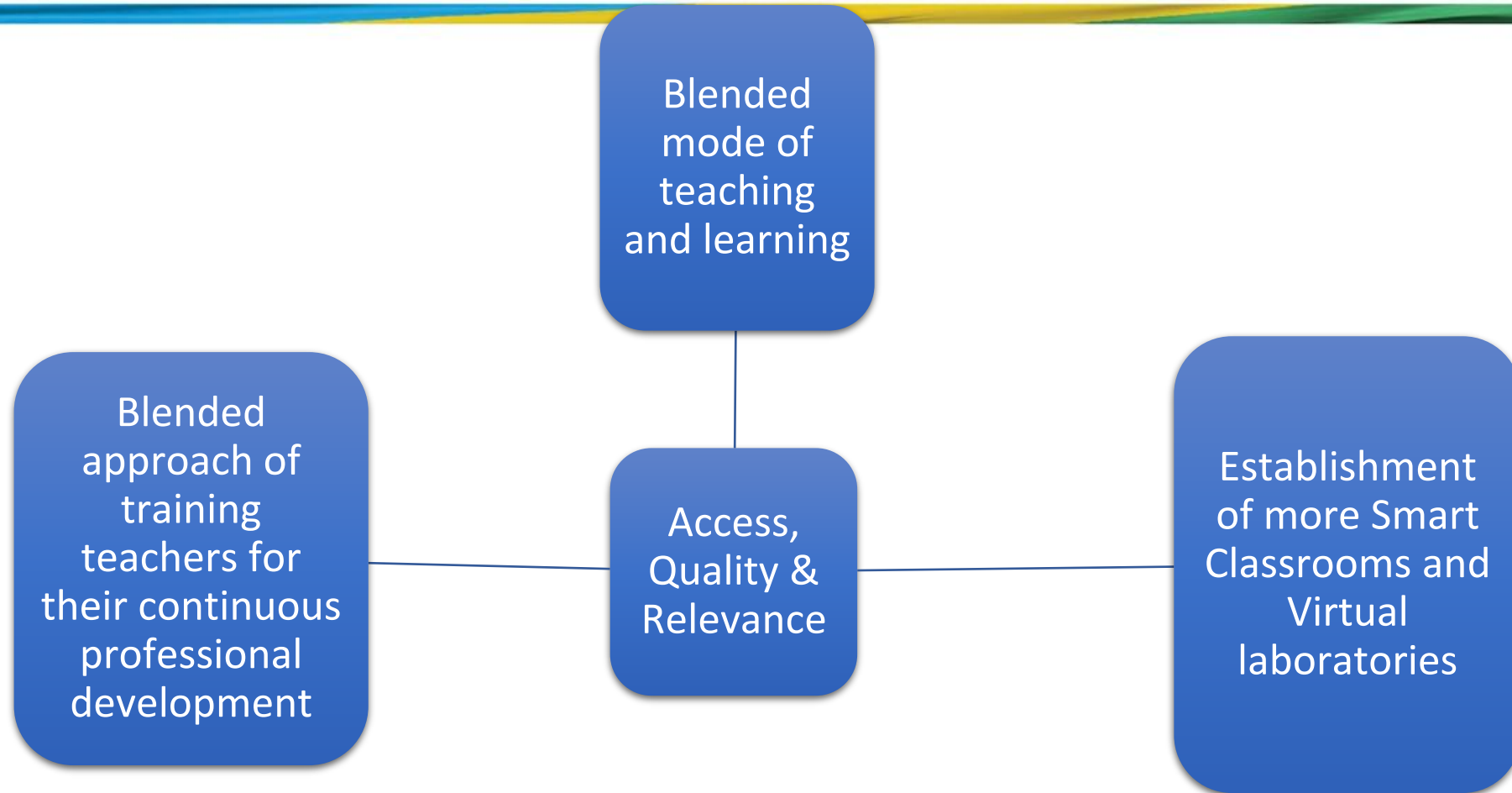
Upgrades of e-Learning platforms in all level of Education. And development of inclusive digital content and revision of teaching programs
