Productive technical education in Ecuador

- Agriculture: a cornerstone for the Ecuadorian economy in 2023
 - Increase in GDP: approx. 9,1% in the productive industries:
 - Aquaculture and Fishing (6,4 %)
 - Cattleship and Agriculture (2,7%)
- Around 28% of young workers between 18 and 29 years old are actively working in the agricultural sector (ILO, 2020).
- TVET schools host approx. 402.309 students enrolled in technical education by 2022 (Ministry of Education, 2022)
- Opportunities for TVET students in the productive sector:
 - Self-employment and agro-entrepreneurship
 - Higher education
 - Job market
- Threats for TVET students in the productive sector:
 - Migration
 - Aging in rural populations
